Tiny Kickers Soccer Coach

Position Description:

The coach is responsible for all aspects of directing the teams practice and play in games. Most of the participants will be playing their first organized soccer game. Each team will have about 8-10 players with one or two assistant coaches.

Activities and Responsibilities:

1. To teach Tiny Kickers Soccer through the use of the games approach and through effectively planned practices at a level appropriate for each member of the team.
2. To organize the players to participate in practice and coach them during the games.
3. To encourage parent involvement and coordinate their assistance.
4. To provide a safe and enjoyable environment for all players, giving each child an equal opportunity to participate.
5. To communicate with the Recreation Director on all matters of policy.
6. To serve as a positive role model to players, parents, and fellow coaches by following all rules, and demonstrating good sportsmanship.
7. To communicate good health and fitness principles and positive character development concepts to players, parents, and spectators.

Qualifications:

- Must have attended the coaches meeting or have reviewed the guidelines and rules with the Recreation Director prior to the first practice.
- Must be of sound mind and good character.

Benefits:

The head coach does receive a \$10 credit to be applied back to their online account if they fulfill their duties.

Coaches also have the opportunity to be of service to the community by providing guidance and leadership of our youth. The positive impact that coaches can have on the lives of young people is an intangible reward impossible to value.
