GENERAL AGENDA ITEMS

1. Polk County Discussion of Additional Coverage

Polk County Officers from the Sheriff's department were present to give the Council information on some different types of additional enforcement that could be used. The Council will be invited at a later date to attend a presentation on a mobile speed device.

4. Request from Park and Recreation Board to discuss a Swimming Pool Sub Committee

The Park and Recreation Board requested to the Council to discuss putting together a swimming pool sub committee. The Council advised that they had no problem with this request but wanted to make it clear that at this time there was no funding for this type of project.

5. Storm Water Fees Discussion

Aaron Boussetot of Fox Engineering provided discussion on a storm water utility fee. He advised how other cities implement this fee. He also advised that this fee could be used to repair and maintain storm water projects along with enforce regulations and comply with NPDES MS4 Permit requirements. Boussetot stated that the City of Grimes will need approximately \$800,000 per year to budget for expenses. The Council will continue to discuss this issue.
