157.01 ADOPTION OF 2009 INTERNATIONAL MECHANICAL CODE. Pursuant to published notice and public hearing as required by law, the 2009 International Mechanical Code, and all the provisions of the International Mechanical Code Standards, published in the 2009 International Mechanical Code are hereby adopted in full except for such portions as may hereinafter be deleted, modified or amended. An official copy of the 2009 International Mechanical Code is on file in the office of the Clerk.

157.02 AMENDMENTS, MODIFICATIONS AND DELETIONS. The following amendments, modifications, additions and deletions to the 2009 International Mechanical Code are hereby made:

Any person desiring a permit required by this Code shall at the time of filing an application therefore pay a fee as required by the City Council, which Council shall adopt by resolution a schedule of fees to be known as mechanical fees which shall upon adoption by the Council be effective until amended or revoked by a comparable resolution and which is on file in the office of the City Clerk at the City Hall.

Mechanical Permit Fee Schedule
New Residential - \$75.00 base fee per dwelling unit
Residential Remodel/Addition/Miscellaneous - \$35.00 base fee
Commercial - Itemized
Except as provided by law, where work has been started prior to obtaining a permit, the regular fee therefore may be doubled at the discretion of the Building Official.

157.03 CONFLICTS WITH STATE LAW. Nothing in this chapter or in the International Mechanical Code shall be construed to be in conflict with State law and in the event there is such a conflict, the State law shall prevail.
